JJVÖ Rules (additions to the JJIF Rules for minors)

II. JJIF Fighting System

II. Section 1 Generalities

For competitors in U8 fighting in part 1 is not permitted.

The fighting time for age categories U8, U10 and U12 is (1x) 2 minutes, for age categories U15 and older is(1x) 3 minutes.

II. Section 2 Material

Competitors in the age categories U10, U12, U15, U18 and U21 must wear a toothguard.

Male competitors in the age categories U10, U12, U15, U18 and U21 must wear a jock strap.

II. Section 3 Kategories

In the age category U8 male and female competitors will only be seperated if necessary.

In the age category U10 male and female competitors will be merged if necessary.

II. Section 8 Points

Allowed Techniques:

U8: Locks and strangulations are allowed (The referee may stop the fight at his discretion

and award points!)

U10 & U12: The following techniques (with semicontact to the body and no contact to the head)

are allowed:

Oi Tsuki Chudan

Gyaku Tsuki Chudan

Uraken Jodan

Mae Geri Chudan

• Mawashi Geri Chudan

U15: Any semicircular Atemi technique without contact to the head (~10 cm distance =

Ippon)

Forbidden Techniques:

U8-U15: Locks to the lower extremities

II. Section 9 Penalties

Forbidden Action(Chui):

- Fighting in part 1 in age category U8
- Punching or kicking with contact to the head in the age categories U10, U12 und U15.
- Application of locks to the lower extremities in the age categories U8-U15.

II. Section 10 End of a match

SinceFull Ippon is impossible to achieve in the age category U8 (no fighting in part I) the fight ends if the margin in points is at least 8 points.

In the age categories U8-U18 the coach may tap instead of his competitor in Part 2 or 3. In Part 2 Ippon (2 points) will be awarded to the opponent, in Part 3 Ippon (3 points) will be awarded to the opponent.

In the age categories U8-U18 the coach may concede the match for his competitor. The fight will be scored with "Kiken-Gachi" (14:0) .

III. Section 3: Categories

In the age category U8 men, mixed and women competitors will only be seperated if necessary.

III. Section 5 Course of the match

The following amount of techniques has to be presented:

U8: 1 technique from series A, B and C of the competitors choice. (total 3 techniques)

U10: 1 technique from series A, B and C of the competitors choice. (total 3 techniques)

U12: 2 techniques from series A, B and C of the competitors choice. (total 6 techniques)

U15: 3 techniques from series A, B and C of the competitors choice. (total 9 techniques)

U18: 3 techniques from Series A, B and C randomized by the referee. (Like Seniors without series D)

In the age categories U8 and U10, all techniques will be presented at once.

JJIF Ne Waza System

V. Section 2 Material

Competitors in the age categories U10, U12, U15, U18 and U21 must wear a toothguard.

V. Section 3 Categories
